<b>Draw:</b>	<p><b>1.</b> Shortly after the closing date the County Union will make the draw for matches for all the pairs entered. <b>2.</b> The first pair named in a match will play at home. <b>3.</b> The final shall be played on a date and course selected by the County Championship Committee. <b>4.</b> The draw will set the final day to play each round, but pairs are expected to liaise and may arrange a match on any mutually convenient earlier date. <b>See also notes on draw sheet.</b> <b>5.</b> Any Club hosting a match must offer a course conforming to CONGU Medal Play Conditions. Preferred Lies, as defined on fairways or through the green, or Temporary Tees are permitted. <b>6.</b> Any pair drawn to play at home, whose course is closed and is unable to host a match arranged on the final day of the round being played, will lose home advantage if the opposing pair's course is open for play and able to accommodate the match on the same day.</p>
